Dear DTSC:

This letter is to inform you that our company will be exporting hazardous waste from the United States (California) to Mexico. Effective date of this NOI is April 15, 2019 which allows for more than 28 days of review before the existing NOI expires on April 15, 2019. The last valid day for this NOI is April 14, 2020. No additional types of waste have been added since the current NOI was submitted.

We have already advised and received permission from the U.S. EPA as well as the Mexican government as stated in the U.S. EPA acknowledgement of consent to export such material. (See attached.)

The attached EPA Acknowledgements of Consents are from January 1, 2019 through October 24, 2019.

(2.iii) Estimated total quantity of hazardous waste to be exported:

Non-RCRA Hazardous waste Liquids, (Anti-freeze, Glycols) 800 tons
Non-RCRA Hazardous waste Liquids, (Oily waters) 800 tons
Non-RCRA Hazardous waste Liquids, (water based paint, inks or adhesives and other listed wastes) 800 tons

(2.iv) Points of Departure of the Hazardous Waste:

Non-RCRA Hazardous Waste exportations will occur through the POD located in Otay Mesa, San Diego, CA. U.S. Customs compound and then enter into Mexico at the Otay Mexican Customs Compound.

(2.v) Hazardous waste will be transported by highway, in box vans or tankers contained in 5, 15, 30, and 55. Or 85 DOT approved shipping containers or tankers containing up to 20 tons of liquid.

(2.vi) Description of the recycling process.

Non-RCRA liquid solutions, will be recycled for waste water recycling reuse in the various processes within Recicladora Temarry de Mexico SA de CV plant. H039, H020 and H050, Handling codes will apply.
